















# Cahuilla Desert Academy

Recommended Supplies for 2019-2020: The following supplies are recommended supplies for all classes to help students be more organized and prepared this coming school year.

Quantity	Item	Example
1	Good quality 3-ring binder. Must be at least 2 in. <b>***AVID students must have 3 in Binder</b>	
5-7 = 1 pack	Subject dividers to separate each academic class.	
2 or more	Pencils and Pens (a variety of colors is helpful; mechanical pencils are preferred)	
1 or more	Colored highlighters	
2 packages	Loose-Leaf filler paper (College Rule)	
3-5	Single Subject notebooks (Science, math, ELA, History, etc)  ** Highly used in Math, ELA and Sci for class journals.	
1	Zipper pouch to store supplies  ** Not Required but useful to keeping things together in binder.  <b>***AVID students must have one</b>	

1	Ruler/hole puncher (yes it is a ruler and a hole puncher)  <b>*** AVID students are highly recommended to have one.</b>		
3	Post it pads  <b>***AVID students must have different colors</b>		
1	Paper reinforcements  <b>*** AVID students are highly recommended to have one.</b>		

Other recommended useful items! (\*\* AVID students)

1	Scotch tape or glue or mini stapler		
1 box	Colored pencils		
1	Binder pocket or clear sleeves to store composition notebook in the binder  ** Not Required but useful to keeping things together in binder.		
1	Pencil sharpener		

**Please keep in mind that this is a list of recommended supplies that we generated from asking all teachers what some of the most important class needs are. The first 6 items are highly recommended and used by all teachers. The shaded items are also highly recommended items for AVID students to have in order to be organized and well prepared. And the last 4 items are items that make being a student easier and more independent.**
